Show Information

ENTRIES/OFFICE

- ❖ **Pre entries close Wednesday, September 13th.** All entries received after this will be charged a post entry fee of \$35/entry.
- ❖ Scratches prior to the close of entries will receive a full refund. Scratches after the closing of pre-entries will be refunded entry fees, however, the \$30 office fee will still apply. Stall fees and pre-ordered hay and shavings are non-refundable after closing date...no exceptions.
- ❖ All entries are required to pay \$2 fee to USHJA, and \$2 fee to NEHC.
- ❖ Returned checks will be charged a fee of \$50. Payment of return fee and initial amount shall be made within 2 weeks of notification.
- ❖ Payment by credit card will be accepted. There will be a 3% fee charged for this service.
- ❖ All prize money will be applied to show bill. Excess winnings will be mailed within 30 days.
- ❖ Prize money will only be awarded in classes with three or more entries.
- ❖ Horse Show Office will open 1 hour prior to start time, and close ½ hour after the end of the show day. Any splits must be made by the end of the show day on Friday.
- ❖ Unjudged warm ups are offered at times posted on the class list at \$20 per round.
- ❖ Horses on the grounds but not showing, will be charged a grounds fee of \$50.
- ❖ As per arrangements with the fairgrounds, horses shipping in and not stabling will be charged a ship in fee of \$20/day or \$45 for the full show (Thursday-Sunday).
- ❖ One NH Medal Class per rider. A horse/pony may only be ridden once in each medal class.
- ❖ All entries for NEHC medal classes must have their membership number or a copy of their temporary membership card with them. Entries without membership numbers will not be accepted. If you know you are a member and cannot remember your number, you can fill out a Membership Affidavit. There is a \$25.00 fee which will be returned to you when your membership is validated. If you join NEHC at the horse show, please make sure you get your Temporary Membership from the show office.

STABLING

- ❖ Horses are allowed on the show grounds no earlier than 8:00 AM on Thursday, September 21st.
- ❖ Horses must be off the show grounds 1 hour after the show concludes on Sunday, September 24th.
- ❖ Stabling will be assigned on a first come, first served basis.
- ❖ Stalls are \$165 if payment is mailed with stall form prior to closing date for entries – September 13th. Stalls increase September 14th to \$185 each. Stall fee includes night watch. Open checks will not be accepted for stall fees. **No refund of stall fees after the closing date of entries...no exceptions.**
- ❖ **Per fairgrounds policy, aisleways must be kept clear. Tack and equipment may not be stored in barn aisles. Please plan accordingly for tack stalls.**
- ❖ **Hay and Shavings available for purchase by pre-order only, and are non-refundable. Hay and Shavings must be pre-ordered on stall form by September 13th.**
- ❖ No altering of stalls is permitted without authorization by fairgrounds. All alterations must be made by fairgrounds staff with a charge of \$25/panel.
- ❖ All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damages incurred by them, their agents or employees to buildings, stalls, rings and other properties on show grounds, and will be billed accordingly.
- ❖ There will be a \$25 fee for staples used on stalls.
- ❖ Extension cords must be grounded (three wire/prong).
- ❖ Parking is allowed only in designated areas. Loading and unloading is permitted next to the barns, otherwise that areas is to be left clear of all vehicles.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- ❖ **Horse Health Requirements include negative coggins within 12 months; EIV (Equine Influenza) and EHV-1/EHV-4 (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccines within 6 months. In addition, horses must have shown no signs of infectious disease and may not had a fever above 102 degrees F within 72 hours of arrival.**
- ❖ Helmets must meet or exceed ASTM/SEI safety standards and be worn at all times while mounted. Chin straps must be properly fitting and securely fastened.
- ❖ Dogs must be leashed at all times and under control. **Dogs are not permitted in the ingate areas for the safety of all.**
- ❖ Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

GENERAL RULES

- ❖ NHHJA management reserves the right to limit entries, cancel, combine, or split any class, section or division; to add a dotted line; to reschedule classes; to change rings; or to change specifications in jumper classes due to time constraints.
- ❖ NHHJA horse shows abide by the rules and regulations of the New England Horsemen's Council.
- ❖ Lungeing and schooling will only be permitted in designated areas.
- ❖ RV spaces are available for a fee of \$100/camper up to 35 feet and \$125/camper over 35 feet long. All RVs must be self-contained. Reservations must be made using the reservation form and returned to Kara Quigley. Email kara.quigley@ymail.com.
- ❖ All incidents on show grounds must be reported to management. This includes any accidents, injuries and property damage.
- ❖ Exhibitors will be financially responsible for any property damages caused by them, or their horse(s). Repair expenses will be billed accordingly, if not during the event, then immediately afterward. Failure to pay will result in suspension of membership until debt is paid in full.
- ❖ **This is a USHJA Outreach competition. See USHJA website (www.ushja.com) for more information. A list of Outreach pointed classes/divisions for this show can be found in the show office.**
- ❖ **No smoking in barns or indoor arena.**
- ❖ **This show is pointed for NHHJA Year End Awards.** All regular NHHJA divisions will be pointed and count toward year end awards. **In order to accumulate year end points, membership fee must be paid AND membership form must be completed prior to the conclusion of the show. Note: Juniors need parent signature.**

CLASSES

116 & 117. Novice Jumpers - Open to any horse or pony with no restrictions. Fences 2'-2'3" in height. First class Table II.2(b) (ties in first round will be broken by time). Second class Table II.1.

1 & 2. Puddle Jumpers - Open to any horse or pony with no restrictions. Fences not to exceed 2'6". First class Table II.2(b) (ties in first round will be broken by time). Second class Table II.1.

10. Open 18" Equitation – Open to junior and amateur adult riders who have not previously shown over fences exceeding 2'. Fence not to exceed 18".

11. NH Team Challenge – Open to junior and amateur adult riders. *Each entrant will be assigned a team.* Each team will collectively complete a written horsemanship exam. Each individual team member will show over an equitation course at respective heights: 18" riders

to go first and 2'3" riders to follow. Individual scores will be tallied (lowest score dropped) for each team. Exam scores will be added to the jumping tally to determine final placing.

12 & 13. Modified Adult Equitation – Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older who haven't shown higher than 2'6" at a recognized show in the current show season. Fence heights 2'3"-2'6".

18 & 19. Short Stirrup Equitation – Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders cannot have shown higher than 18" at any recognized show.

NEHC "A"

Short Stirrup Equitation Flat – to be judged at the walk, trot and canter in both ways of the ring. May be asked to halt and back. No more than 8 to canter at one time.

Short Stirrup Equitation O/F – to be shown over a minimum of 4 fences and a maximum of 8 fences, with fences not to exceed 18" in height. Fences may be taken at a trot or canter.

Entry fee: \$35/class

Trophy and eight (8) ribbons

20 & 21. Long Stirrup Equitation – Open to riders 13 years of age and older. Riders cannot have shown higher than 2' at any recognized show.

Long Stirrup Equitation Flat – to be judged at the walk, trot and canter in both ways of the ring. May be asked to halt and back. No more than 8 to canter at one time.

Long Stirrup Equitation O/F – to be shown over a minimum of 4 fences and a maximum of 8 fences, with fences not to exceed 18' in height. Fences may be taken at a trot or canter.

22. Walk Trot Equitation – Open to riders ten (10) years of age and younger. Riders may not have cantered or loped at any previous show. To be judged on equitation at walk and trot.

23. Walk Trot Pleasure – Open to riders ten (10) years of age and younger. Riders may not have cantered or loped at any previous show. To be judged on suitability of pony and rider at walk and trot.

95. Walk Trot Ground Poles – Open to riders ten (10) years of age and younger. Riders may not have cantered or loped at any previous show. To be judged on equitation over a simple course of poles.

24 & 25. Children's Equitation – Open to junior riders who have never shown higher than 3' at any recognized show. Fence heights not to exceed 2'6" for horses/large ponies, 2' for small/medium ponies.

26 & 27. Adult Equitation – Open to amateur adult riders. Fence heights not to exceed 2'9".

30 & 31. Hunt Seat Equitation 15-17 – Open to junior riders ages 15-17. Fence heights not to exceed 3'.

99 & 100. NEHC Amateur Adult Medal - Open to adult amateur members of the New England Horseman's Council. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences set at a height from 2'9" to 3' with a combination and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-17). To fill a class, at least three competitors must complete the course.
Entry fee: \$40/class *Trophy and eight (8) ribbons*

101 & 102. NEHC Junior Medal - Open to Junior members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences set to a height from 3' to 3'3" with a combination and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-17). To fill a class, at least three competitors must complete the course.

118. \$500 Novice Jumper Classic – Open to any horse or pony with no restrictions. Table II.2(b). Ties in first round will be broken by time. Fences 2'-2'3" in height.

35. Leadline Equitation Championship– Open to riders eight (8) years of age and younger. Leaders and side walkers must be over the age of fourteen (14) and formal dress is suggested. To be judged on equitation at walk and trot.

36. Leadline Pleasure Championship– Open to riders eight (8) years of age and younger. Leaders and side walkers must be over the age of fourteen (14) and formal dress is suggested. To be judged on suitability of pony and rider at the walk and trot.

37. Walk-Trot Equitation Championship – Open to riders ten (10) years of age and younger. Riders may not have cantered or loped at any previous show. To be judged on equitation at walk and trot.

40. NH Novice Medal Final – Junior and amateur riders must have qualified (accumulated 10 or more points in 2023) for the class in order to compete at the Finals. Open to junior and amateur adult riders who have never shown higher than 2’ at a recognized show. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of eight (8) fences with at least one change of direction. 25% of the class will be called back for testing. USEF tests 1-8. Fence heights not to exceed 18”.

41. Open Modified Children’s Flat - Open Modified Children’s Equitation - Open to junior NHHJA members, in good standing, who are qualified for the NH Modified Children’s Medal. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. *NON-POINTED for year end awards.

42. NH Modified Children’s Medal Final – Junior riders must have qualified (accumulated 10 or more points in 2023) for the class in order to compete at the Finals. Open to junior riders who have never shown higher than 2’6” at a recognized show. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of eight (8) fences with at least one change of direction. 25% of the class will be called back for testing. USEF tests 1-8. Fence heights not to exceed 2’3”.

43. Open Modified Adult Equitation Flat - Open to amateur adult NHHJA members, in good standing, who are qualified for the NH Modified Adult Medal. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. *NON-POINTED for year end awards.

44. NH Modified Adult Medal Final – Amateur riders must have qualified (accumulated 10 or more points in 2023) for the class in order to compete at the Finals. Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older who haven't shown higher than 2'6" at a recognized show in the current show season. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of eight (8) fences with at least one change of direction. 25% of the class will be called back for testing. USEF tests 1-8. Fence heights 2'3"-2'6".

45. Open Children's Equitation Flat - Open to junior NHHJA members, in good standing, who are qualified for the NH Children's Medal. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. *NON-POINTED for year end awards.

46. NH Children's Medal Final – Junior riders must have qualified (accumulated 10 or more points in 2023) for the class in order to compete at the Finals and must not have previously shown over fences exceeding 2'9" at a recognized show. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of eight (8) fences with at least one change of direction. 25% of the class will be called back for testing. USEF tests 1-8. Fence heights not to exceed 2'6".

Trophy and ten (10) ribbons

47. Open Adult Equitation Flat - Open to amateur adult NHHJA members, in good standing, who are qualified for the NH Adult Medal. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. *NON-POINTED for year end awards.

Trophy and eight (8) ribbons

48. NH Adult Medal Final – Amateur riders must have qualified (accumulated 10 or more points in 2023) for the class in order to compete at the Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of eight (8) fences with at least one change of direction. 25% of the class will be called back for testing. USEF tests 1-19. Fence heights not to exceed 2'9".

Trophy and ten (10) ribbons

49. Open Junior Equitation Flat - Open to junior NHHJA members, in good standing, who are qualified for the NH Junior Medal. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter. *NON-POINTED for year end awards.

Entry fee: \$35

Trophy and eight (8) ribbons

50. NH Junior Medal Final - Junior riders must have qualified (accumulated 10 or more points in 2023) for the class in order to compete at the Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of eight (8) fences with at least one change of direction. 25% of the class will be called back for testing. USEF tests 1-19. Fence heights not to exceed 3'.

Trophy and ten (10) ribbons

HUNTER CLASSES

51. Hunter Pleasure – Open to all horses of a hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations to status of rider. Light contact with horse's mouth is required. To be judged on performance, manners, quality, presence, suitability, substance and soundness. Open to horses only.

Trophy and eight (8) ribbons

52. Pony Hunter Pleasure – Open to all ponies of a hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes. Adults are permitted to show ponies with suitability to count; light contact with the pony's mouth is required. To be judged on performance, manners, quality, presence, suitability, substance and soundness.

Entry fee: \$35

Trophy and eight (8) ribbons

103. NEHC Pleasure – Open to NEHC members and non-members. Open to all horses ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to the status of rider or place of residence. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Will be required to back. Loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality in that order.

NEHC "C"

Trophy and eight (8) ribbons

53, 54 & 55. Baby Green Hunter – Open to any horse or pony in their first two years of showing over fences. Horses and ponies may not cross enter in other divisions with jumps exceeding 2'6", and may not to have previously shown over fences exceeding 2'6" in height at any recognized show. Simple changes of lead should not be penalized. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

56, 57, & 58. Open Special Hunter – No limitations as to status of horse or rider. Fence heights not to exceed 2'6".

59, 60, & 61. Pre-Child/Adult Hunter – Open to horse/rider combinations who have not previously shown over fences exceeding 2'6" at any recognized show. Fence heights not to exceed 2'.

Entry fee: \$35/class and \$40/Stake

NEHC "B"

Trophy and eight (8) ribbons

Stake Prize Money (\$50, \$25, \$15, \$10)

62, 63 & 64. Children's Hunter Horse – To be shown by junior exhibitors, age as of December 1st of the current show year. Junior exhibitors 15-17 years of age must be eligible for intermediate equitation O/F (have not won 12 blue ribbons) as of Dec. 1st of the current show year. Fences not to exceed 3'0, spreads not to exceed fence height. Same horse/rider combinations may not compete in any other NEHC rated division at the same show except equitation, jumpers, and pleasure. Horses may be shown by another rider in any other division at the same show. Jogging for soundness at the discretion of the judge. Shall be judged on performance and soundness. Fence heights not to exceed 3'.

65, 66, & 67. Performance Hunter – No limitations as to status of horse or rider. Fence heights not to exceed 3'3".

68, 69 & 70. Amateur Adult Hunter – To be ridden by amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as juniors. Horse/rider combinations are not eligible for any other NEHC rated hunter classes. Horses may be shown by a different rider in any other divisions or classes at the same show. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners and way of going, size of rider to mount and suitability as an amateur adult hunter. Horses may be jogged for soundness at the judge's discretion. Fence heights not to exceed 3'. Spreads not to exceed height of fence. Ponies may be ridden by adults, suitability to count. NEHC "B"
