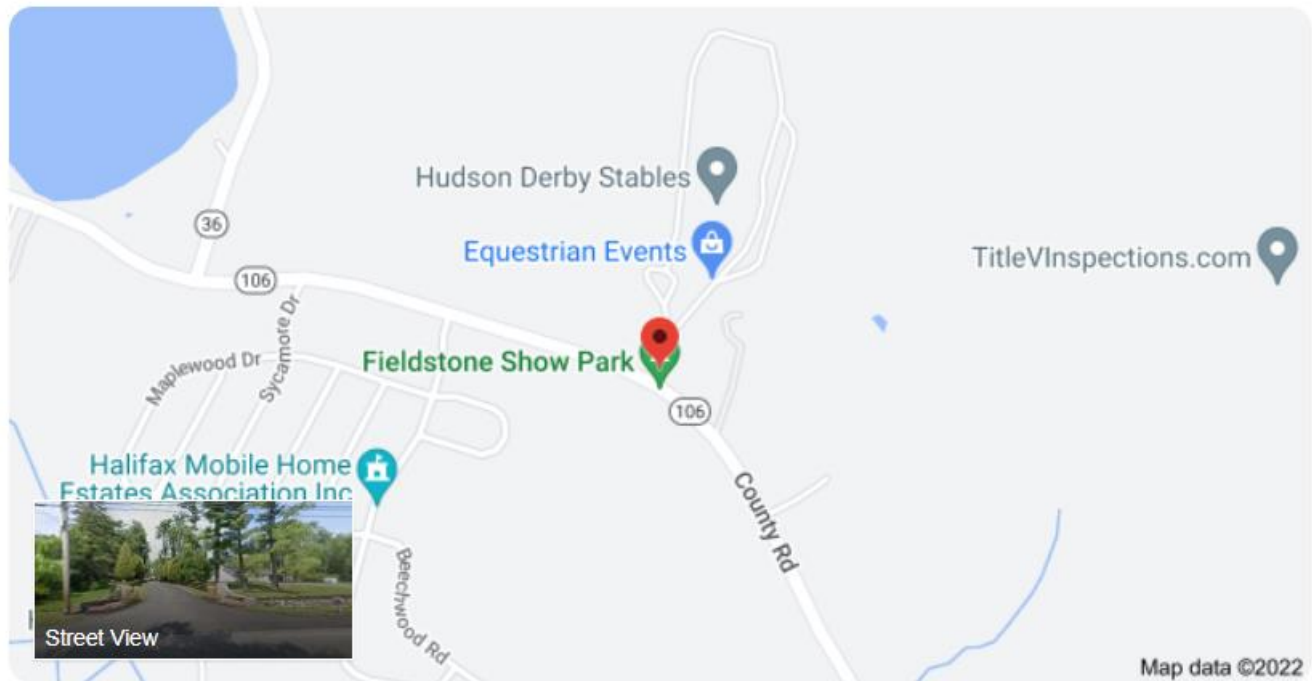

Directions to Fieldstone Show Park – 21 Plymouth St. Halifax, MA

From the North: Take I-93 S to Route 3 via Exit 7 toward Cape Code, Braintree. Keep LEFT to merge onto MA-3 S. Take MA-3 to route 3A via Exit 9 toward Kingston, N Plymouth. Turn right onto Main St. go .5 miles and turn left to stay on Main St. continue onto Wapping Rd. go 4.6 miles and turn right onto Plymouth St.
ALTERNATE is to avoid the center of Boston and the tunnels take 93 to 495 S and follow directions for from the West.

From Maine:
Take 95 S to I-93 S to Route 3 via Exit 7 toward Cape Code, Braintree. Keep LEFT to merge onto MA-3 S. Take MA-3 to route 3A via Exit 9 toward Kingston, N Plymouth. Turn right onto Main St. go .5 miles and turn left to stay on Main St. continue onto Wapping Rd. go 4.6 miles and turn right onto Plymouth St.

From West:
Take I-495 S, to Route US- 44 via Exit 6 toward Middleboro, Plymouth. On US-44 go .3 miles turn right onto Harding St. then proceed to the roundabout, take the third exit onto US-44E. Follow US-44 to exit for MA-58 toward Carver, Plympton. Proceed for .3 miles and turn left onto N. Main St.. On N. Main St. go 2.3 miles then turn right on Main St. Follow Main St. for 2.3 miles and turn left onto County Rd. then proceeding .9 miles and turn right onto Plymouth St.

Summer Festival Horse Show Information – Rules and Regulations

- **All riders who wish to accumulate points for NHHJA year end awards and NH Medal points must be NHHJA members. Horse owners who wish to have their horses accumulate year end must be members.** Membership forms available at Show Office.

ENTRIES/OFFICE

- ❖ All entries accepted after Wednesday, June 21st will be charged a post entry fee of \$30/entry.
- ❖ Scratches prior to the close of entries will receive a full refund. **Scratches after the closing of pre-entries will be refunded entry fees, however, a \$50 scratch fee will apply, and stall fees will not be refunded.**
- ❖ All entries are required to pay \$2 NEHC fee, \$2 USHJA fee, and \$1 MHC fee.
- ❖ Returned checks will be charged a fee of \$50. Payment of return fee and initial amount shall be made within 2 weeks of notification.
- ❖ Payment by credit card will be accepted at the show. There will be a 3% fee charged for this service.
- ❖ Unjudged Derby Warm Ups are open only to horses entered in the coinciding Derby class. There will be a scratch fee of \$30 for all derby classes scratched after the derby warm up.
- ❖ ALL JUMPER CLASSICS, HUNTER CLASSICS & HUNTER DERBIES require that the horse MUST compete in at least one other class at this show to be eligible.
- ❖ Horse show office will open 1 hour prior to start time, and close 1/2 hour after the end of show day. Any splits must be made by the end of the show day on Friday.
- ❖ Horses on the grounds but not showing, will be charged a grounds fee of \$75.
- ❖ A \$40 grounds fee will be charged to all entries. This will include unjudged warm ups on Tuesday only.
- ❖ Unjudged warm ups will be offered in Hunter Ring 2 and Hunter Ring 3 Wednesday through Sunday, as posted on the class list, for a fee of \$10 per round. Hunter Ring 1 and Jumper Ring will be open for hacking only Wednesday through Sunday mornings at posted times.
- ❖ All prize money will be applied to show bill. Excess winnings will be mailed within 30 days.

STABLING

- ❖ Horses are not permitted on the show grounds before 3:00PM on Monday, July 3rd.
- ❖ Horses must be off the show grounds 1 hour after the show concludes on Sunday, July 9th.
- ❖ Stalls are \$285 each for the week if payment is made in full, and mailed with stall form, prior to closing date for entries (June 21st). Stalls not paid for by closing date will be \$325 each. Open checks will not be accepted for stall fees. **No refund of stall fees after the closing date of entries...NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- ❖ A mandatory night watch fee of \$15.00 per stall occupied by a horse will be added to your show bill. This fee cannot be disputed.
- ❖ Hay and shavings can be pre-ordered on stall form.
- ❖ If box fans are used, they must have 3 prong plugs. No exceptions.

- ❖ **Exhibitors will be financially responsible for any property damages caused by them, or their horse(s). Repair expenses will be billed accordingly, if not during the event, then immediately afterward. Failure to pay will result in suspension of membership until debt is paid in full.**

CAMPERS

- ❖ A limited number of RV spaces are available for weekly fee of \$350. Electric and water are included. All RVs must be self-contained. **Reservations are first come, first served and must be made prior to the show! All reservations must be made using the reservation form and submitted to Kara Quigley. Email kara.quigley@ymail.com. Be sure you receive a confirmation!**

HEALTH & SAFETY

- ❖ Horse Health Requirements include negative coggins within 12 months; EIV (Equine Influenza) and EHV-1/EHV-4 (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccines within 6 months. In addition, horses must have shown no signs of infectious disease and may not had a fever above 102 degrees F within 72 hours of arrival.
- ❖ Helmets must meet or exceed ASTM/SEI standards and be worn at all times while mounted. Chin straps must be securely fastened.
- ❖ Dogs must be leashed at all times.
- ❖ Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

GENERAL RULES

- ❖ NHHJA management reserves the right to limit entries, cancel, combine, or split any class, section or division; to add a dotted line; to reschedule classes, change rings, or change specifications in jumper classes due to time constraints.
- ❖ Please note that there will be no holds on flat classes in Jumper Ring and Hunter Ring 1 for trainer conflicts.
- ❖ NHHJA horse shows abide by the rules and regulations of the New England Horsemen's Council and USEF.
- ❖ All entries for NEHC medal classes must have their membership number or a copy of their temporary membership card with them. Entries without membership numbers will not be accepted. If you know you are a member and cannot remember your number, you can fill out a Membership Affidavit. There is a \$25.00 fee which will be returned to you when your membership is validated. If you join NEHC at the horse show, please make sure you get your Temporary Membership from the show office.
- ❖ Lunging and schooling will only be permitted in designated areas. Please do not lunge or school on the grass!
- ❖ Horses are not permitted on the derby field other than during derby classes.
- ❖ NHHJA is an USHJA affiliate Organization and part of the USHJA Outreach Program please see their website at <https://www.ushja.org/competition/outreach> for more information on the program.

SUMMER FESTIVAL CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

The United States Equestrian Federation (USEF, www.usef.org) requires ALL persons mounted on a horse to wear properly fitted ASTM approved helmet with harness secured.

HUNT SEAT EQUITATION DIVISIONS

No rider may enter classes for more than one age group. The exhibitors' age for competition will follow NEHC rules, age as of December 1. Points can be accumulated only in the age group indicated on the application for membership. Martingales are prohibited on the flat.

Prize and 8 ribbons in each class. Champion and Reserve Champion in each division.

***SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION** – Open to riders 12 years of age and under. Riders cannot have shown higher than 18" at any recognized show. In flat class, no more than 8 horses to canter at a time.

***MODIFIED CHILDREN'S EQUITATION** – fences not to exceed 2'3". Open to junior riders. Riders cannot have shown in classes higher than 2'6" at any recognized show.

Entry Fee: \$105 for division or \$40 per class

***MODIFIED ADULT EQUITATION** – fences 2'3"-2'6". Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older who haven't shown higher than 2'6" at a recognized show in the current show season. Riders in this division cannot show in any other classes at the same show where fences exceed 2'6".

15. MODIFIED ADULT EQUITATION - FLAT

EQUITATION CLASSICS

45. APPLE KNOLL FARM EQUITATION CHALLENGE - To be run in a Washington International Horse Show Equitation Classic format, including a hunter phase, jumper phase and work-off. To be judged on style and execution with respect to the hunter and jumper disciplines. This class is offered to and junior or young adult riders who have not reached their 21st birthday. Fences are to be 3' high, with spreads not exceeding fence height. Competitors must ride the same horse in all phases. Numerical scores to be given in the hunter and jumper phases. Standing Martingales are permitted.

Hunter Phase: To be ridden over a hunter classic-type course with at least 8 fences, at 3'. The course must include at least 2 changes of direction after the first fence, at least 3 spread fences, and a combination. To be judged on overall style and execution with regard to the hunter discipline. Ribbons for first through sixth place of the hunter phase will be awarded.

Jumper Phase: Riders from the hunter phase will return in reverse order for the jumper phase. To be ridden over a timed jumper-type course with at least 8 fences, at 3'. The course must include at least 2 changes of direction after the first fence, and at least 3 spread fences, and at least one combination. A time-allowed will be determined using the speed of 360 yards per minute. Time and jumping faults should be taken into consideration in the judge's evaluation of the rider. To be judged on overall style and execution with regard to the jumper discipline. Ribbons for first through sixth place of the jumper phase will be awarded.

Work-off: The 6 riders with the highest combined score from both phases will return for a work-off. USEF tests 1-19. Ribbons and prize.

MEDAL CLASSES

Entry Fee: \$45 per medal class unless otherwise noted.

46, 47. NH ADULT MEDAL – fences not to exceed 2'9". Amateur riders 18 years of age and older must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional. *USEF Tests 1-18. NH Adult Medal and NH Junior Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height.*

48, 49. NH JUNIOR MEDAL – fences not to exceed 3'. Junior riders must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional. *USEF Tests 1-18. NH Junior Medal and NH Adult Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height.*

50, 51. NH CHILDREN'S MEDAL - fence heights not to exceed 2'6" for horses/large ponies; 2' for small/medium ponies. Open to junior and amateur adult riders who have not shown higher than 3' at any recognized show. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction and no combination. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional. *USEF Tests 1-8. NH Children's Medal, NH Modified Children's Medal and/or NH Modified Adult Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height.*

52, 53. NH MODIFIED CHILDREN'S MEDAL – fence heights not to exceed 2'3". Open to junior riders who haven't shown higher than 2'6" at a recognized show. Must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction and no combination. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional. *USEF Tests 1-7. NH Children's Medal, NH Modified Children's Medal and/or NH Modified Adult Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height.*

54, 55. NH MODIFIED AMATEUR ADULT MEDAL – fence heights 2'3"-2'6". Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older who haven't shown higher than 2'6" at a recognized show in the current show season. Must accumulate 10 points to qualify for NH Medal Finals. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction and no combination. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. *USEF Tests 1-7. NH Modified Adult Medal, NH Modified Children's Medal and/or NH Children's Medal may be combined if there are not enough entries to fill them separately. To be shown at respective height.*

56, 57. NH NOVICE MEDAL – fence heights not to exceed 18". Open to junior and amateur adult riders who haven't shown higher than 2' at a recognized show. Must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 6 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional.

58. DOWNEAST WALK-TROT POLES MEDAL - Open to riders 14 years and under. Must not have shown over fences higher than 18". Contestants shall be required to show at a trot over a minimum of four rails (poles) on the ground. Testing optional. Verbal testing recommended.

59. DOWNEAST SHORT & LONG STIRRUP MEDAL

DOWNEAST SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION MEDAL -

Open to riders 12 years of age and under, competing on horses or ponies. Riders must never have shown over fences higher than 18". Riders shall be required to perform a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence height will be 18". If a rider wins the medal final, they are no longer eligible to compete in this division. 25% of contestants, at least 2, may be called back for individual testing. Testing optional, verbal recommended. USEF tests 1-8. Both Short and Long Stirrup may compete together at the qualifying shows, however they will be separated at the Finals into Short Stirrup 12 & under, and Long Stirrup 13 and over through adults.

DOWNEAST LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION MEDAL

Open to riders 13 years of age and older through amateur adults. All riders must be in their first three years of showing over fences and must never have competed in a class or division with fences higher than 18". Adults may apply for review under rule #27 if they have shown higher than 18" in the past 3 years and show extenuating circumstances. If a rider wins the medal final, they are no longer eligible to compete in this division. Riders shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence height will be 18". 25% of contestants, at least 2, may be called back for individual testing. Testing optional, verbal recommended. USEF tests 1-8. All adult equitation riders must have proof of amateur status from MHA, NHHJA, NEHC, USEF or any recognized breed organization. Both Short and Long Stirrup may compete together at the qualifying shows, however they will be separated at the Finals into Short Stirrup 12 & under, and Long Stirrup 13 and over through adults.

60. DOWNEAST MINI MEDAL - Open to riders 17 years of age and younger, competing on ponies. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2' for small/medium ponies and 2'6" for large ponies/horses. Testing optional. USEF tests 1-8. Shows hosting qualifying classes may combine the Mini Medal and the Amateur Adult Medal if there are not enough riders to fill them separately.

61. DOWNEAST MODIFIED JUNIOR MEDAL- Open to riders 17 years of age and younger, competing on ponies or horses. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'3". Testing optional. USEF tests 1-8. Shows hosting qualifying classes may combine the Modified Junior Medal and the Modified Adult Medal if there are not enough riders to fill them separately.

62. DOWNEAST JUNIOR MEDAL - Open to riders 17 years of age and under competing on horses. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'9". Testing optional. USEF tests 1-19.

63. DOWNEAST MODIFIED ADULT MEDAL - Open to amateur riders 18 years of age or older, competing on horses or ponies. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'3". Testing optional. USEF tests 1-8. Shows hosting qualifying classes may combine the Modified Junior Medal and the Modified Adult Medal if there are not enough riders to fill them separately.

64. DOWNEAST AMATEUR ADULT MEDAL - Open to amateur riders 18 years of age or older, competing on horses or ponies. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of six fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'6". Testing optional. USEF tests 1-19. Shows hosting qualifying classes may combine the Mini Medal and the Amateur Adult Medal if there are not enough riders to fill them separately.

65, 66. NEHC ADULT MEDAL - Open to adult amateur members of the New England Horseman's Council. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences set at a height from 2'9" to 3' with a combination and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-19). To fill a class, at least three competitors must complete the course. If there are not 3 riders in either or both the Junior or Adult Hunt Seat Medal qualifying class, they can be combined to meet the 3 rider minimum. Riders would show at their respective heights. Junior riders would still need a win to qualify. Point system for adult riders would stay the same. Once qualified a contestant is no longer eligible to compete in qualifying classes for that year.

67, 68. NEHC JUNIOR MEDAL - Open to Junior members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least eight fences set to a height from 3' to 3'3" with a combination and two changes of direction after the first obstacle. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-19). To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course. To fill a class, at least three competitors must complete the course. If there are not 3 riders in either or both the Junior or Adult Hunt Seat Medal qualifying class, they can be combined to meet the 3 rider minimum. Riders would show at their respective heights. Junior riders would still need a win to qualify. Point system for adult riders would stay the same. Once qualified a contestant is no longer eligible to compete in qualifying classes for that year.

69, 70. MHC JUNIOR HUNT SEAT MEDAL- Open to Junior members of MHC who have not reached their 18th birthday. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences not to exceed 3'. Ten points are required to qualify for finals. After qualifying, a contestant is no longer eligible for this class. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF tests 1-19). To fill the class, at least 3 competitors must complete the course.

71, 72. MHC AMATEUR ADULT HUNT SEAT MEDAL - Open to adult members of MHC. All contestants are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'6"-2'9", with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top 4 contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. To fill a class, at least 3 competitors must complete the course. After qualifying, a contestant is no longer eligible for this class.

73, 74. MHC HUNT SEAT MINI MEDAL – Open to members of MHC who have not reached their 15th birthday and have not competed in classes in which the entry is required to jump higher than 3'. All contestants are to compete over a course not exceeding 2'6" for ponies and horses. One or more test may be requested at the judge's discretion. (USEF current tests 1-8). After qualifying, a contestant is no longer eligible for this class. To fill the class, at least 3 competitors must complete the course.

234, 235. MHC ADULT HUNT SEAT MINI MEDAL - Open to adult members of MHC who have not jumped 2'9" or higher in the past 2 years. All contestants are to perform over a course not exceeding 8 fences and not less than 6 fences, excluding combinations and a height not to exceed 2'6" for horses and ponies. To fill a class, at least 3 competitors must complete the course. Riders **may** compete after qualifying. If there is not a minimum of riders of either or both the Mini Medal or Adult Mini Medal qualifying class, the show can combine to meet the rider requirement. Riders will show at their respective heights.

3. MHJ SHORT STIRRUP MEDAL (class #3 qualifying class) – Open to all junior riders who have not reached their 13th birthday as of December 1st of the current show year. To perform over at least four fences not to exceed 18". Riders **may not** compete in any other equitation class other than Short Stirrup Equitation, at any show and shall not have competed in a class jumping over 18". 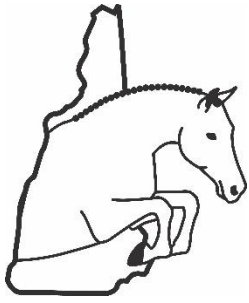

All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damages incurred by them, their agents or employees to buildings, stalls, rings and other properties on show grounds, and will be billed accordingly.

I agree to hold harmless New Hampshire Hunter Jumper Association and NEHC, its employees and volunteers, officers, and showground staff from any damage or injury that occurs to any horse or rider, including myself, that I bring to any of the New Hampshire Hunter Jumper Association horse shows at Brookvale Pines Farm in Fremont, NH; The Fieldstone Show Park in Halifax, MA, and the Three County Fairgrounds, Northampton, MA or at any other NHHJA sanctioned event.

Per NEHC Bylaw: Every entry at a recognized show shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that the person making it, along with the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider, and the horse: (1) shall be subject to the Constitution and rules of the Association and the local rules of the show; (2) that every horse, rider, and/or driver is eligible as entered;(3) that the owner and any of his representatives are bound by the Constitution and Rules of the NEHC and the show will accept as final the decision of the hearing committee on any question arising under said rules and agree to hold the show, the NEHC, their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken; (4) that the owner, rider/driver and any of their agents or representatives agree to hold the NEHC, the show, and their officials, directors, employees and agents harmless for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show, whether or not such injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of the NEHC or show.

Management reserves the right to decline or refuse any entry, without being liable for compensation, and eliminate from further competition any exhibitor or horse, should the best interest of the show be served. Every exhibitor, or agent, and trainer must sign an entry blank. In the event of failure to do so, the first entrance into the ring as an exhibitor, shall be construed as acceptance of the rules of the show and of NEHC, and shall ipso facto render exhibitor subject to said rules. No entry is permitted in the ring that is ineligible for competition.

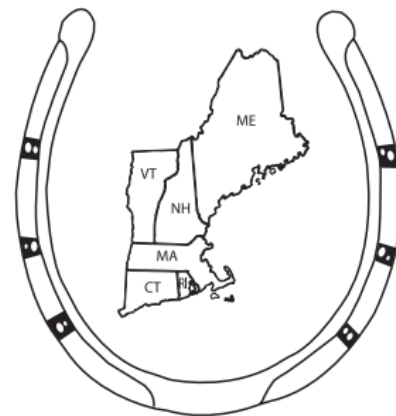
